Further to my emailed letter earlier today, I ask you to update us on your family situation regarding critical/key workers and vulnerable children.

Should the situation change, nationally or locally, we will remain open to vulnerable children and those children who have one or both parents classed as a critical/key worker. All other children will move to remote learning.
